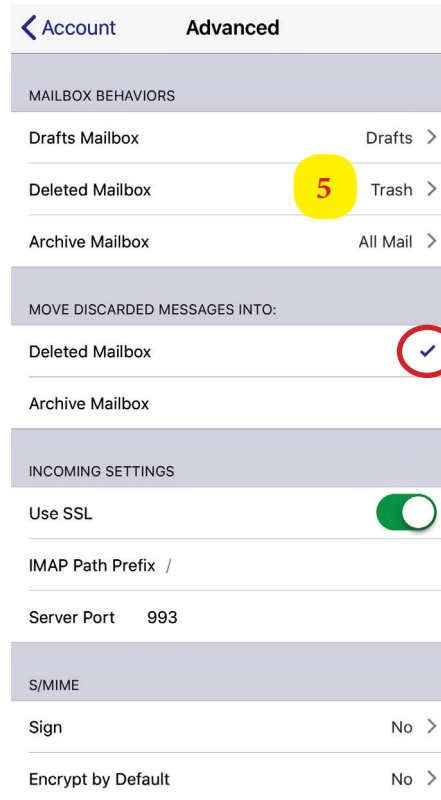
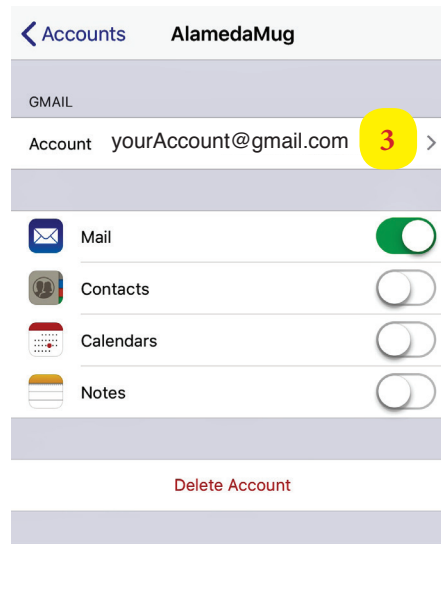

iOS Settings to Discard Gmail to Trash instead of saving it in Google's default email Archive

Hint: it's not in the Mail settings.

1. Settings > **Passwords & Accounts**
2. Select > for your Gmail Account
3. Click on email account name >
4. Click the Advanced >
5. Click > for Deleted Mailbox
6. Set Trash as target on the server for deleted email messages.

(Google's default is to archive email for long-term data collection.)
